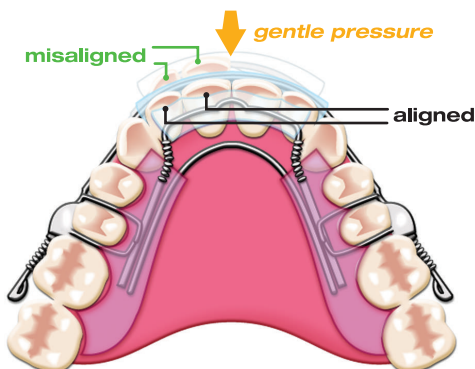
Rotated, crowded anterior teeth.
